## **IMPORTANT**

- 1. All Ph.D. students MUST complete the Program of Studies form. The Program of Studies form should be filed with at least 45 hours remaining to be taken.
- 2. If you have obtained a M.S. degree from a reputed institution either in the USA or abroad, you are eligible to transfer certain number of credits. Please take advantage of this feature.
- 3. All Ph.D. students MUST complete the Supervisory Committee form. The Appointment of Supervisory Committee form should be filed before you completed 45 credit hours.
- 4. Please fill out the form and get signatures.
- 5. Please fill them out with your advisor (i.e. Anu Subramanian) as soon as possible and hand them into me in 207 Othmer.
- 6. There is no direct admission into Ph.D. at UNL. You will need to have a Master's degree completed and on file to be admitted as a Ph.D. student.
- 7. The above requirements are not to be confused with proposal defense or candidacy exam. Proposal defense is an oral examination where: (1) you will defend your research proposal and (2) write a 6-page proposal on an unrelated topic.
- 8. To take candidacy examination, you will need to have completed the Program of Studies form and the Supervisory Committee form.
